- Schreiber was founded in Green Bay in 1945 by L.D. Schreiber, Merlin G. Bush and D. David Nusbaum.
- Schreiber's Home Office is at 425 Pine St. in Green Bay. Also in the Green Bay area are culinary, distribution, engineering, production, and research and development facilities.
- Schreiber helps make northeast Wisconsin a better place through fundraising activities and grants; employee volunteer involvement; and product donations. Highlights include:
 - Annual Fundraising Campaign – Through employee and company contributions, Schreiber raises more than \$500,000 each year to support non-profit organizations in the area. The funds are distributed through Schreiber Community Fund grants, United Way and other programs.
 - Schreiber Charity Golf Classic – Representatives from key Schreiber suppliers visit Green Bay each July to participate in the annual fundraising event. Schreiber covers the entire cost of the golf outing, and all proceeds – which totaled more than \$210,000 in 2008 and more than \$2.7 million in the first 18 years of the event – are earmarked for a specific charity each year.
 - Volunteer involvement – Schreiber employees serve on the boards of non-profit organizations, volunteer their time individually and participate in company team projects like the Adopt-A-School, Rebuilding Together and The Salvation Army Holiday programs.
 - Product donations – In 2008 Schreiber donated more than 5,000 pounds of cheese and other products to non-profit organizations in the Green Bay area.
